Teacher Guide:

1. Read the story, *What if?*, and remind children that when they ask themselves, "What if?", they give themselves time to think about what could happen as a result of their actions.
2. Have children cut out the seed and put it somewhere (like on a backpack, in a pocket, or on a handmade poster) that will help them remember to ask themselves, "What if?"
